

# Mentoring Students: AKADAMICS & Xomidhan



### **Xomidhan**

- Launched in 2010 as a career counselling service
- Provides career counselling via emails, seminars and articles in newspapers and magazines.
- Consists of more than 300 active counselors
- Answered more than 1000 queries ,multiple seminars in Assam
- Recipient of various prestigious awards like e-Northeast for Information.
- Registered as an NGO in 2014



## **Scholarship & Mentoring**

- AKADAMICS and Xomidhan have come together to start the program
- AKADAMICS will provide the scholarship where as Xomidhan will provide mentorship.



## **Highlights**

- 20 students given scholarship by AKADAMICS 2016
- Plan to take 5-10 students for Mentorship.
- 2 students wants to study prepare for civil services and we have a mentor who cleared civil service exams
- 1 student wants to study Astro physics and we have a mentor who is working in Japan as an astrophysics engineer.



# AFNA Focus & Budget 2016



#### **2016** Focus Areas & Needs

- Education of underprivileged students
  - Support A Child (support 100 students: \$10,000)
  - AKADAMICS (support 48 students \$10,000)
- Employment-generation programs for the poor
  - Support a Disabled Worker at ANeC (support 10 disabled worker: \$5000)
  - Support Disabled Artisans at Swabalambi (8 trainers : \$4800)
- Volunteering in local communities in USA

We would need another \$5000 to explore and kick off other new initiatives

Total funds needed in 2016: \$35,000 Funds raised so far ~\$15,000
