- Only Assamese origin students residing and studying in USA, Canada or Mexico can participate in the contest.
- Essays must be no longer than 1500 words in length, submitted in English.
- Only Word (.doc) or PDF files can be submitted.
- Only one entry per student is allowed, and each entry must be the work of only one student.
- Essay entries cannot have already been published.
- Any essays found to be plagiarized will be automatically disqualified.
