

Relief for Covid-19 affected families in Guwahati City Report submitted by Foundation for Social Transformation

Foundation for Social Transformation-enabling north-east India in collaboration with AFNA undertook the project titled Relief for Covid-19 affected families in Guwahati City during the period October-December, 2021. The objective of the project was to provide support for 25 urban poor families of Ujan Bazar area, Guwahati impacted by Covid19 for rehabilitation of their business. FST identified 25 families from Ujan Bazar & Hatigaon area and provided them support in kind to rebuild their livelihood like sewing machine, fish selling utensils for fish sellers and beauty parlour chairs.

Relief to Mid-west Tornado victims: By Sarfaraz Taher

On Dec 10th, 2021, an unseasonal tornado hit the tri-state region of Missouri, Kentucky and Illinois and caused massive devastation. Lives of over 100,000 families were impacted and a few lives were lost. AFNA team swung into action and immediately contributing funds to local foodbanks in the Lexington, KY, and St. Louis, MO, areas for 30,000 meals to support those impacted by the devastating Tornados. The foodbanks were chosen on making the maximum and widest geographical impact. These foodbanks have matching support from local corporate giants and therefore AFNA's contributions were matched up to 4 times maximizing the overall impact.
